

Message from the Chairperson

The Board continued to be highly active with requests for hearings and decisions from co-management partners and users of wildlife throughout the Nunavut Settlement Area. The meetings, hearings and other activities that were carried out during the course of the past fiscal year are outlined below.

The Chairperson's appointment had not been finalized by March 31, 2010. Harry Flaherty, a Board member, continued in the role of Acting Chairperson until his term ended February 17, 2010. Harry was re-appointed to the Board, by Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated, effective February 24, 2010. Willie Nakoolak has been Acting Chairperson of NWMB since February 2010. Other Board Member changes during the 2009-2010 year are as follows: Makabe Nartok was replaced by Peter Qayutinuak, appointed by the Kitikmeot Inuit Association, during October 2009 and; Pitseolak Alainga, was replaced by Peter Kusugak, nominated by INAC and appointed to the NWMB Board effective February 10, 2010. One Board member vacancy remained at the end of the fiscal year, that being the Department of Environment (CWS) nomination.

The Board bid farewell to Joe Justus, Director of Wildlife during October and to Charlotte Sharkey, Wildlife Management Biologist during March. One new staff member, Robert Kidd was hired

The development of the second Nunavut Wildlife Harvest Study (HS 2) has been delayed somewhat as the Board re-assessed its planning and implementation stages.

The NWMB received and considered recommendations from the Fisheries Advisory Committee on both turbot and shrimp allocations for 2010 and made a number of allocation decisions for the Nunavut Settlement Area.

The Nunavut Wildlife Research Trust (NWRT) is operated by the same NWMB Board Members who, upon appointment, are automatically "Trustees." The Trust Fund made an excellent comeback after the downturn during late 2008 and early 2009. The quick recovery was due to a major portion of the asset mix being in "Fixed Income."

The board allocated \$751,500 towards government departments' wildlife research projects for the 2009-2010 year. The Board approved a total of 19 projects, single year research projects and the final year of several multi-year research projects.

during this period as NWMB filled the position of Director of Wildlife Management. One Biologist position was vacant at year-end. The Board had also approved two new Management Biologist positions so it could become more proactive in its work. A new Director of Finance and Administration, Dave Rogers, was hired during March to overlap for three months and replace the incumbent, Tom Demcheson, who was retiring in June after 14 years of service with the Board. We wish Tom some much needed rest. The Board would like to thank its staff for their dedication and perseverance during a very busy past year.

The Board held 3 Regular Meetings, 8 Conference Call Meetings, 5 In-Camera Meetings, 9 Internal In-Camera Meetings as well as 2 Public Hearings regarding a Total Allowable Harvest (TAH) for Baffin Bay Polar Bear and a TAH for Kingnait Fiord Arctic Char. Staff attended the three Regional Wildlife Organizations' annual general meetings as well as science meetings regarding various species.

The NWMB also approved \$58,500 from its Nunavut Wildlife Studies Fund for two community-based research projects for which local HTOs, RWOs and other local non-government organizations are eligible.

Much progress was made during the latter part of the 2009-2010 year on the drafting/redrafting of four Policy Manuals for Governance, Wildlife, Human Resources, and Finance and Administration. The Board also completed a review of its Salaries and Benefits to ensure it remains competitive with other similar organizations in attracting qualified, long-term staff.

A workshop was held for Board Members regarding Inuit Qaujmajatuqangit (IQ) and its use in making wildlife decisions, following the report, "A Critical Review of the Use of Inuit Traditional Knowledge" which was completed for the Board during the 2008-09 year. Further work with wildlife partner agencies on the use of IQ in wildlife decision making is expected to continue.

When the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board's 2009/2010 Annual Report is published it will be distributed to all the wildlife partners including: the community Hunters' and Trappers' Organizations, Regional Wildlife Organizations, Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated, Federal and Territorial governments as well Indian and Northern Affairs Canada. This report will also be distributed to all Nunavut schools and community libraries. The NWMB annual report is published in English, Inuktitut and Innuinaqtun languages. The section of the annual report covering "NWMB Implementation Activities" provides the reader with extensive details of the activities and progress of the NWMB. Many of the activities are "works in progress." The report also contains audited financial statements for both the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board and the Nunavut Wildlife Research Trust including, the listing of individual Research Projects.

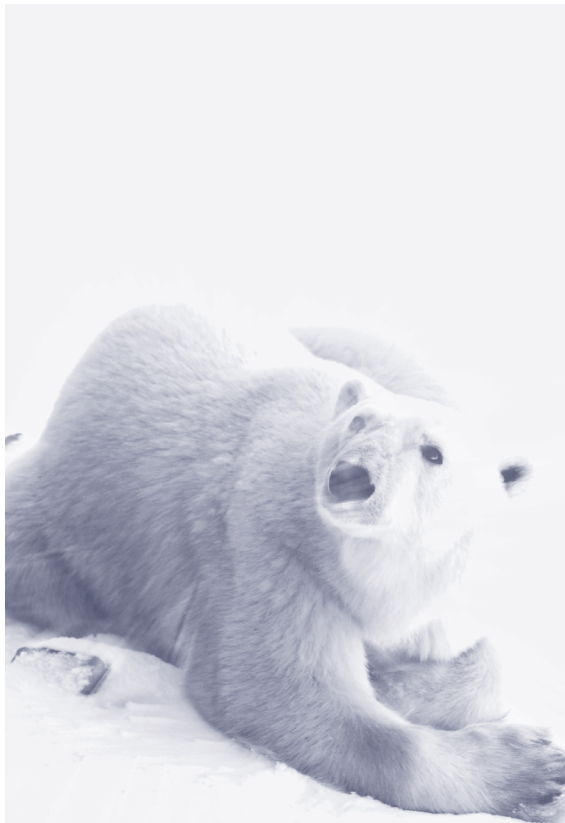

NWMB Implementation Activities

During the 12 months from April 1st 2009 to March 31st 2010, the NWMB continued to perform its core functions in a thorough and timely fashion, and to ensure the continued maintenance of a model wildlife management system that has the confidence of the public, Inuit and Government. Set out in this section is a description of the nineteen NWMB implementation activities undertaken during the 2009-2010 period. Below each general activity, written in blue, is a progress report of specific results and achievements.

- a) Finalize the design and commence the implementation of the second Nunavut Wildlife Harvest Study (HS2):** Carry out a "Pilot Study" in two Nunavut communities, followed by the commencement of the phased-in expansion of HS2 to a wider array of communities selected by the NWMB;
 - The Board held numerous harvest study steering committee meetings regarding the implementation of the study.
 - The Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB or Board) had to postpone undertaking the second harvest study. A contractor awarded to conduct the study was unable to fulfill the commitments in the contract. On October 14, 2009 a letter was sent to the contractor terminating the contract.
- b) Continue the introduction of the *Total Allowable Harvest-Basic Needs Level-Surplus* (TAH-BNL-Surplus) management regime for particular stocks or populations of species in the NSA;**
 - The NWMB requested further stock status and structure information for beluga/narwhal for the future establishment of TAH-BNL.
 - The NWMB held a public hearing on TAH-BNL-Surplus for Kingnait Fiord char (June 2009).
 - The Board solicited an outside legal opinion on the criteria for the establishment of BNLs.
 - The Board held a public hearing and decision-making session on proposed modifications to the TAH for Baffin Bay polar bear.
- c) Pursuant to the principles of conservation, and in conformity with the development and initial introduction of the TAH-BNL-Surplus management regime, make appropriate decisions with respect to maintaining, establishing, modifying or removing TAHs and other restrictions on wildlife harvesting in the NSA;**
 - The Board made a number of non-quota limitation decisions pertaining to commercial fisheries.
 - The Board reviewed and approved three bowhead whale hunt plans.
 - The Board made a decision on modifications to the Baffin Bay polar bear TAH.
 - The Board approved various sport hunt applications for walrus for the 2010 harvest season.
 - The Board approved a humane harvest of beluga at Targioyak Fiord, Pangnirtung.



- d) Conduct Public Hearings, as necessary, into issues of high public importance that require NWMB decisions;
- The Board conducted public hearings on the establishment of a Total Allowable Harvest (TAH), Basic Needs Level (BNL) and surplus, if any, on Kingnait Fiord char (June 2009) and proposed modifications to the TAH for Baffin bay polar bear (September 2009).
- e) Equitably allocate Nunavut's share of commercial shrimp, turbot, and other marine resources among eligible fishers;
- The Board made decisions on the 2010 allocations for shrimp and turbot in 0A and 0B.
- f) In cooperation with the NWMB's relevant co-management partners, continue the development of a Nunavut Fisheries Licensing Policy;
- The Government of Nunavut's Fisheries and Sealing Division is the recognized lead Nunavut agency to work on the development of a new licensing policy. The NWMB's understanding is that the GN has entered into a contract with a qualified consultant to prepare a draft policy for review by the GN and NWMB. As soon as the GN/consultant share their initial work towards development of the draft policy, the NWMB will commence a review and be in a position to report progress on this activity.
- g) Continue to implement the *Allocation Policy of the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board for Commercial Marine Fisheries*;
- Conducted consultations with Nunavut fishing stakeholders on implementation of the new FAC Allocation policy
 - Held an FAC conference call to decide on allocations for 2010.
 - FAC held an allocation recommendation session (summer 2009)
- h) Complete the review and analysis of the Community-Based Management (CBM) system for narwhal and beluga whales, and provide advice and recommendations to the DFO Minister regarding the continuation of and improvements to this program;
- Completed review of narwhal CBM including in-community consultations in participating communities.
 - Provided recommendations on the future of the CBM program and narwhal management to the DFO Minister.
 - Prepared and scheduled for the review of beluga CBM to be completed by January 2010, which includes in-community consultations in participating communities.
- i) Continue to promote the inclusion of both IQ and modern science in all aspects of wildlife management;
- The NWMB's September 2009 Baffin Bay polar bear hearing focused on the inclusion of both IQ and science in the management of that polar bear population.
 - The NWMB's June 2009 Kingnait Fiord arctic char hearing focused on the inclusion of both IQ and science in the consideration of the establishment of TAH-BNL-Surplus.
 - The Board reviewed the consultants report on the use of IQ in wildlife management and is currently evaluating the next steps on how to move forward.
- j) Make appropriate decisions with respect to the approval of plans for the management and/or protection of particular wildlife or wildlife habitats;
- The Board approved three bowhead whale hunt plans.
 - The Board approved the establishment of three new National Wildlife Areas (NWA).
 - The Board approved various walrus sport hunts for the 2010 harvest season.
 - The Board initiated the review process of the interim walrus sport hunt policy.
- k) Continue to provide guidance and advice on wildlife management and research proposals and priorities;
- Initiated the review process of the Board's Nunavut Wildlife Research Trust and Nunavut Wildlife Studies Fund research policies.
 - NWMB staff met with university and government researchers to provide advice on scientific and IQ research.
 - Held a meeting between managers, fishers and Inuit organizations on conducting research in support of an in-shore turbot fishery in Cumberland Sound.
- l) Continue to evaluate Government and non-government Research Funding Proposals, and to provide funding to researchers from the *Nunavut Wildlife Research Trust (NWRT)* and the *NWMB Studies Fund (NWSF)*;
- The NWMB approved 2009-2010 NWRT funding in the amount of \$751,500 for 19 research projects, and 2009-2010 NWSF funding in the amount of \$58,500 for 2 research projects.
 - The Board ensured that funding conditions were met and finalized the Contribution Agreements and released the funding for the 2009-2010 funding period for the NWRT and NWSF approved research proposals.
 - The NWMB sent call letters to Government Departments and Regional Wildlife Organizations (RWOs) and Hunters and Trappers Organizations for the upcoming 2010-2011 fiscal year.
- m) Continue to ensure that wildlife research data and results from projects funded by the NWMB are made available to the public – particularly through the Nunavut Wildlife Resources Coalition Centre (NWRCC) libraries – and encourage others to do likewise;
- The NWMB received final reports for previous funded research projects, which it filed in the NWRCC library system.
 - The NWRCC website is continually maintained on a consistent basis.
 - The NWRCC annual meeting was conducted by the Board.
- n) Continue to attend consultations between Canada and Greenland on shared wildlife stocks, and continue to work with administrative agencies and aboriginal peoples from other land claims areas concerning shared wildlife stocks;
- NWMB staff attended the Canada/Greenland Joint Commission on Narwhal and Beluga (JCNB) meeting held in Greenland (May 2009).

- NWMB staff attended and participated in a number of meetings and conference calls with the Advisory Committee on the Cooperation of Wildlife Management (ACCWM) to continue the work on interjurisdictional wildlife matters.
 - NWMB staff attended the 15th annual international IUCN Polar Bear Specialist Group (PBSG) meeting held in Denmark (June-July 2009).
 - NWMB initiated discussions with the Nunavik Marine Regional Wildlife Board (NMRWB) and Makivik related to wildlife issues dealing with areas of equal use and occupancy.
- o) Continue to provide funding to the RWOs and HTOs through the Nunavut Inuit Wildlife Secretariat (NIWS);
- Provided core funding to RWOs/HTOs for the first, second and third quarters.
- p) Continue to communicate and work in cooperation with HTOs, RWOs, the NIWS, NTI and Government Departments, and with other institutions of public government (IPGs) concerning land and resource management issues affecting Nunavut;
- The NWMB is currently in the process of re-evaluating its role in land and resource management issues.
 - NWMB staff participated in a Nunavut Marine Council (NMC) meeting (October).
- q) Work towards completing the NLCA decision-making processes for draft harvesting limitations in the Wildlife Regulations and Orders proposed by the GN under Nunavut's new *Wildlife Act*;
- The Board made two final decisions as per the NLCA decision-making process for the draft Harvesting Regulations.
- The Board is currently corresponding with the GN regarding a way forward for the remaining final decisions for the Wildlife Regulations and Orders.
- r) Continue to implement the DFO – Environment Canada – NWMB *Memorandum of Understanding to Harmonize the Designation of Rare, Threatened and Endangered Species under the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement and the listing of Wildlife Species at Risk under the Species at Risk Act* (MOU);
- NWMB staff and Government representatives are developing an NWMB focused SARA workshop for the Board.
 - The NWMB is currently following the MOU process for the following seven species: peregrine falcon, polar bear, red knot (*islandica*), red knot (*rufa*), short-eared owl, Cumberland sound beluga and Eastern-High Arctic-Baffin Bay beluga.
- s) Continue to work closely with Government and Inuit in ensuring that new and amended legislation affecting Nunavut recognizes and respects land claims agreements and the jurisdictions of land claims bodies (e.g. progress in development of the *Nunavut Fishery Regulations*, as well as Regulations and Orders required pursuant to the territorial *Wildlife Act*);
- NWMB staff attended a Nunavut Fishery Regulations meeting (July 2009)

Notes to The Financial Statements

For the Year Ended March 31, 2010

1. NATURE OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB) is an institution of public government established pursuant to *An Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada*, also known as the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement*. The NWMB is the main instrument of wildlife management and the main regulator of access to wildlife in the Nunavut Settlement Area (NSA). In addition, the NWMB identifies research requirements, funds research and carries out research in order to help maintain an effective system of wildlife management in the NSA. The Board also exercises an extensive advisory authority in the marine environment adjacent to the NSA.

The Board is exempt from income taxes under Sec. 149(1)(l) of the *Income Tax Act*.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies followed by the Board are in accordance with Canadian generally accepted accounting principles and include the following significant accounting policies:

(a) Use of Estimates

The preparation of the financial statements of the Board requires management to make estimates and assumptions based on information available as of the date of the financial statements. Therefore, actual results could differ from those estimates.

(b) Revenue Recognition

The deferral method of revenue recognition is followed. Revenue is recognized in the year in which the related expenses are incurred.

(c) Financial Instruments

The Board's financial instruments consist of cash, accounts receivable and accounts payable and accrued liabilities.

Financial instruments are reported at their fair values on the statement of financial position. The fair values are the same as the carrying values due to their short term nature.

It is management's opinion that the Board is not exposed to significant interest, currency or credit risks arising from these financial instruments unless otherwise noted.

(d) Equipment

Equipment is recorded at cost. Depreciation is provided annually at rates calculated to amortize the assets over their estimated useful lives as follows:

4. DEFERRED REVENUE

Deferred revenue relates to the unspent portion of contributions received from the Department of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada during the 2010 fiscal year which have been approved by the Department for application to project expenditures to be incurred in the 2011 fiscal year.

5. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The NWMB pays for all overhead expenses pertaining to the operations of The Nunavut Wildlife Research Trust, a related party whose Trustees are also board members of the NWMB. There are no inter organizational charges made for these services and their magnitude has not been established.

6. COMMITMENTS

The Board is committed to minimum annual lease payments under the terms of a lease agreement for its office premises as follows:

The agreement expires June 30, 2013. Payments are to be adjusted each year for inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index. After 2010, the payments will be adjusted to reflect the fair market rental value of the premises.

7. OPERATING CONTRIBUTION CARRY FORWARD

The Government of Canada, through the Department of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada, budgets funds allocated for the use of the NWMB for periods of 10 years during which all allocated funds must be spent or they may be retained by the Government. The current period expires in June, 2013. As at March 31, 2010 amounts totaling \$2,872,133 have been approved for carry forward to be used in addition to regular yearly funding for approved programs any time up to June, 2013.



Notes to The Financial Statements

For the Year Ended March 31, 2010

1. PURPOSE AND NATURE OF THE ORGANIZATION

In 1994, pursuant to *A Contract Relating to the Implementation of the Nunavut Final Agreement*, the Government of Canada provided the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB) with a single payment of eleven million dollars for the establishment of a Wildlife Research Fund. Its intended purpose was to provide funding for territorial and federal government departments to carry out wildlife research approved by the NWMB.

Upon that basis, the NWMB established the Nunavut Wildlife Research Trust, which was designated a Registered Charity in 1996. Its Trustees are the members of the NWMB. Since 1997, the Trust has provided an annual funding allocation, exclusively available to government departments. That allocation is administered by the NWMB, in order to address wildlife research priorities as identified by the NWMB.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies followed by the Trust are in accordance with Canadian generally accepted accounting principles and include the following significant accounting policies:

(a) Use of Estimates

The preparation of the financial statements of the Trust requires management to make estimates and assumptions based on information available as of the date of the financial statements. Therefore, actual results could differ from those estimates.

(b) Fund Accounting

The Nunavut Wildlife Research Trust follows the restricted fund method of accounting for contributions.

(c) Financial Instruments

The Trust's financial instruments consist of cash, marketable securities, accounts receivable and accounts payable and accrued liabilities.

Cash, accounts receivable and accounts payable and accrued liabilities are reported at their fair values on the statement of financial position. The fair values are the same as the carrying values due to their short term nature.

Marketable securities are reported at their fair values on the statement of financial position at year end quoted market prices.

The Trust is exposed to market risk with respect to its marketable securities. Market risk is the risk of a financial loss resulting from adverse changes in underlying interest rates, foreign exchange rates, and equity prices.

3. MARKETABLE SECURITIES

The investment in marketable securities is used to fund research. The cost of these securities at March 31, 2010 is \$19,372,482 (2008 \$19,322,622).

4. RISK MANAGEMENT

The Trust manages its market risk through an independent investment manager with oversight from the Trustees.

5. DUE TO NUNAVUT WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT BOARD

The Trust had transactions with the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (the NWMB), a not for profit organization under the same management. During the year ended March 31, 2009, the NWMB advanced the amount of \$40,000 to the Trust to cover short term obligations. The Trust repaid all amounts owing to the NWMB early in the fiscal 2010 year. These transactions were interest free and payable on demand.

6. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

The Trust receives administrative services at no charge from the NWMB. The amount of these services has not been quantified.

7. INCOME TAX STATUS

The Trust is exempt from income taxes under Sec. 149(1)(f) of the Income Tax Act.
